Psalm 24:7-8, Matthew 25:31-32, Acts 1:10-11, I Thessalonians 4:16-5:11

Lift up your heads, O gates! And be lifted up, O ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in. (Psalm 24:7)

Who is this King of glory? The LORD, strong and mighty, the LORD, mighty in battle! (Psalm 24:8)

"When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on his glorious throne. (Matthew 25:31)

Before him will be gathered all the nations, and he will separate people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. (Matthew 25:32)

And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes, (Acts 1:10)

and said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the Same way as you saw him go into heaven." (Acts 1:11)

For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. (I Thessalonians 4:16)

Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord. (I Thessalonians 4:17)

Therefore encourage one another with these words. (I Thessalonians 4:18)

Now concerning the times and the seasons, brothers, you have no need to have anything written to you. (I Thessalonians 5:1)

For you yourselves are fully aware that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. (I Thessalonians 5:2)

While people are saying, "There is peace and security," then sudden destruction will come upon them as labor pains come upon a pregnant woman, and they will not escape. (I Thessalonians 5:3)

But you are not in darkness, brothers, for that day to surprise you like a thief. (I Thessalonians 5:4)

For you are all children of light, children of the day. We are not of the night or of the darkness. (I Thessalonians 5:5)

So then let us not sleep, as others do, but let us keep awake and be sober. (I Thessalonians 5:6)

For those who sleep, sleep at night, and those who get drunk, are drunk at night.(I Thessalonians 5:7)

But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, having put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation. (I Thessalonians 5:8)

For God has not destined us for wrath, but to obtain salvation

through our Lord Jesus Christ, (I Thessalonians 5:9)

who died for us so that whether we are awake or asleep we might live with him. (I Thessalonians 5:10)

Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as You are doing. (I Thessalonians 5:11)
