Responsive Reading Regarding the Poor

"When you reap the harvest of your land, you shall not reap your field right up to its edge, neither shall you gather the gleanings after your harvest.

(Leviticus 19:9)

And you shall not strip your vineyard bare, neither shall you gather the fallen grapes of your vineyard. You shall leave them for the poor and for the sojourner: I am the LORD your God. (Leviticus 19:10)

"For six years you shall sow your land and gather in its yield, (Exodus 23:10)

but the seventh year you shall let it rest and lie fallow, that the poor of your people may eat; and what they leave the beasts of the field may eat. You shall do likewise with your vineyard, and with your olive orchard. (Exodus 23:11)

Whoever despises his neighbor is a sinner, but blessed is he who is generous to the poor. (Proverbs 14:21)

Whoever oppresses a poor man insults his Maker, but he who is generous to the needy honors him. (Proverbs 14:31)

"Is not this the fast that I choose: to loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the straps of the yoke, to let the oppressed go free, and to break every yoke? (Isaiah 58:6)

Is it not to share your bread with the hungry and bring the homeless poor into your house; when you see the naked, to cover him, and not to hide yourself from your own flesh? (Isaiah 58:7)

And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up. And as was his custom, he went to the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and he stood up to read. (Luke 4:16)

And the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was given to him. He unrolled the scroll and found the place where it was written, (Luke 4:17)

"The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, (Luke 4:18)

to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." (Luke 4:19)

And he lifted up his eyes on his disciples, and said: "Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God. (Luke 6:20)

But when you give to the needy, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, (Matthew 6:3)

But when you give a feast, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind, (Luke 14:13)

and you will be blessed, because they cannot repay you. For you will be repaid at the resurrection of the just." (Luke 14:14)

And he sat down opposite the treasury and watched the people putting

money into the offering box. Many rich people put in large sums. (Mark 12:41)
And a poor widow came and put in two small copper coins, which make a penny. (Mark 12:42)

And he called his disciples to him and said to them, "Truly, I say to you, this poor widow has put in more than all those who are contributing to the offering box. (Mark 12:43)

For they all contributed out of their abundance, but she out of her poverty has put in everything she had, all she had to live on." (Mark 12:44)

For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you by his poverty might become rich. (II Corinthians 8:9)

So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith. (Galatians 6:10)
