

## The Eighth Commandment WSC # 73-75 and WLC # 140-142

1. All the e\_\_\_\_\_ belongs to G\_\_\_\_\_ (Psalm 24:1 and 89:11).
2. “It is by the s\_\_\_\_\_ w\_\_\_\_\_ of God, therefore, that man is given the right to p\_\_\_\_\_ in r\_\_\_\_\_ service to Him” (G.I. Williamson – Genesis 1:29, Acts 5:4 and 17:26, Matthew 25:19-46).
3. The commandment requires the l\_\_\_\_\_ p\_\_\_\_\_ and f\_\_\_\_\_ (getting and keeping) of our own and our neighbor’s w\_\_\_\_\_ and o\_\_\_\_\_ e\_\_\_\_\_ (our “stuff” and theirs). WSC # 73 does not specify the lawful ways to do so. Can we do so with Biblical prooftexts?
4. The commandment requires us to do all our w\_\_\_\_\_ as unto G\_\_\_\_\_ and not unto m\_\_\_\_\_ (Colossians 3:22-4:1).
5. The commandment requires us to have hearts that t\_\_\_\_\_ in God’s p\_\_\_\_\_ c\_\_\_\_\_ (Matthew 6:33 and Malachi 3:10) and that are free from e\_\_\_\_\_ (Luke 12:15, Psalm 73:3, I Timothy 6:6-10), l\_\_\_\_\_ (Proverbs 6:6-11), and “inordinate p\_\_\_\_\_ and a\_\_\_\_\_ worldly goods” (WLC # 142 – Psalm 62:10, Proverbs 23:19-21 and 30:7-9).
6. The commandment requires us to take g\_\_\_\_\_ c\_\_\_\_\_ of all of our p\_\_\_\_\_ (Proverbs 27:23-27).
7. Among other things, the commandment forbids d\_\_\_\_\_ in c\_\_\_\_\_ (Zechariah 8:16-17, Amos 8:5, Proverbs 11:1), “v\_\_\_\_\_ l\_\_\_\_\_” (Deuteronomy 1:16-17 and Proverbs 3:29-30), neglecting b\_\_\_\_\_ in n\_\_\_\_\_ whom we are a\_\_\_\_\_ to help (James 2:15-16 and I John 3:17), and failure to seek r\_\_\_\_\_ when s\_\_\_\_\_ has taken place (Leviticus 6:2-5 and Luke 19:8).
