## Responsive Reading

"You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will not hold him guiltless who takes his name in vain. (Exodus 20:7)

**Now an Israelite woman's son, whose father was an Egyptian, went out among the people of Israel. And the Israelite woman's son and a man of Israel fought in the camp,** (Leviticus 24:10)

and the Israelite woman's son blasphemed the Name, and cursed. Then they brought him to Moses. His mother's name was Shelomith, the daughter of Dibri, of the tribe of Dan. (Leviticus 24:11)

**And they put him in custody, till the will of the LORD should be clear to them.** (Leviticus 24:12)

Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, (Leviticus 24:13)

**"Bring out of the camp the one who cursed, and let all who heard him lay their hands on his head, and let all the congregation stone him.** (Leviticus 24:14)

And speak to the people of Israel, saying, Whoever curses his God shall bear his sin. (Leviticus 24:15)

**Whoever blasphemes the name of the LORD shall surely be put to death. All the congregation shall stone him. The sojourner as well as the native, when he blasphemes the Name, shall be put to death.** (Leviticus 24:16)

Then the high priest tore his robes and said, "He has uttered blasphemy. What further witnesses do we need? You have now heard his blasphemy. (Matthew 26:65)

**What is your judgment?" They answered, "He deserves death."** (Matthew 26:66)

Behold my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen, in whom my soul delights; I have put my Spirit upon him; he will bring forth justice to the nations. (Isaiah 42:1)

**He will not cry aloud or lift up his voice, or make it heard in the street;** (Isaiah 42:2)

a bruised reed he will not break, and a faintly burning wick he will not quench; he will faithfully bring forth justice. (Isaiah 42:3)

**He will not grow faint or be discouraged till he has established justice in the earth; and the coastlands wait for his law.** (Isaiah 42:4)

He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth; like a lamb that is led to the slaughter, and like a sheep that before its shearers is silent, so he opened not his mouth. (Isaiah 53:7)

**By oppression and judgment he was taken away; and as for his generation, who considered that he was cut off out of the land of the living, stricken for the transgression of my people?** (Isaiah 53:8)

And they made his grave with the wicked and with a rich man in his death, although he had done no violence, and there was no deceit in his mouth. (Isaiah 53:9)

**Yet it was the will of the LORD to crush him; he has put him to grief; when his soul makes an offering for guilt, he shall see his offspring; he shall prolong his days; the will of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.** (Isaiah 53:10)

For what credit is it if, when you sin and are beaten for it, you endure? But if when you do good and suffer for it you endure, this is a gracious thing in the sight of God. (1 Peter 2:20)

**For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example, so that you might follow in his steps.** (1 Peter 2:21)

He committed no sin, neither was deceit found in his mouth. (1 Peter 2:22)

**When he was reviled, he did not revile in return; when he suffered, he did not threaten, but continued entrusting himself to him who judges justly.** (1 Peter 2:23)

For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. (Romans 5:6)

**For one will scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—**(Romans 5:7)

but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8)

**Since, therefore, we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God.** (Romans 5:9)

For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life. (Romans 5:10)

**More than that, we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation.** (Romans 5:11)
