## Consecrated by God

Responsive Reading: Christ's Burial and Resurrection

I have set the LORD always before me; because he is at my right hand, I shall not be shaken. (Psalm 16:8)

**Therefore my heart is glad, and my whole being rejoices; my flesh also dwells secure.** (Psalm 16:9)

For you will not abandon my soul to Sheol, or let your holy one see corruption. (Psalm 16:10)

**You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore.**

(Psalm 16:11)

"Brothers, I may say to you with confidence about the patriarch David that he both died and was buried, and his tomb is with us to this day.

(Acts 2:29)

**Being therefore a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him that he would set one of his descendants on his throne,**

(Acts 2:30)

he foresaw and spoke about the resurrection of the Christ, that he was not abandoned to Hades, nor did his flesh see corruption. (Acts 2:31)

**This Jesus God raised up, and of that we all are witnesses** (Acts 2:32)

And they made his grave with the wicked and with a rich man in his death, although he had done no violence, and there was no deceit in his mouth. (Isaiah 53:9)

**Yet it was the will of the LORD to crush him; he has put him to grief; when his soul makes an offering for guilt, he shall see his offspring; he shall prolong his days; the will of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.** (Isaiah 53:10)

"Come, let us return to the LORD; for he has torn us, that he may heal us; he has struck us down, and he will bind us up. (Hosea 6:1)

**After two days he will revive us; on the third day he will raise us up, that we may live before him.** (Hosea 6:2)

Then some of the scribes and Pharisees answered him, saying, "Teacher, we wish to see a sign from you. (Matthew 12:38)

**For just as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the great fish, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.** (Matthew 12:40)

They went on from there and passed through Galilee. And he did not want anyone to know, (Mark 9:30)

**for he was teaching his disciples, saying to them, "The Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of men, and they will kill him.**

**And when he is killed, after three days he will rise."** (Mark 9:31)

And though they found in him no guilt worthy of death, they asked Pilate to have him executed. (Acts 13:28)

**And when they had carried out all that was written of him, they took him down from the tree and laid him in a tomb.** (Acts 13:29)

But God raised him from the dead, (Acts 13:30)

**and for many days he appeared to those who had come up with him from Galilee to Jerusalem, who are now his witnesses to the people.** (Acts 13:31)

Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you stand, (I Corinthians 15:1)

**and by which you are being saved, if you hold fast to the word I preached to you-- unless you believed in vain.** (I Corinthians 15:2)

For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, (I Corinthians 15:3)

**that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures.** (I Corinthians 15:4)
