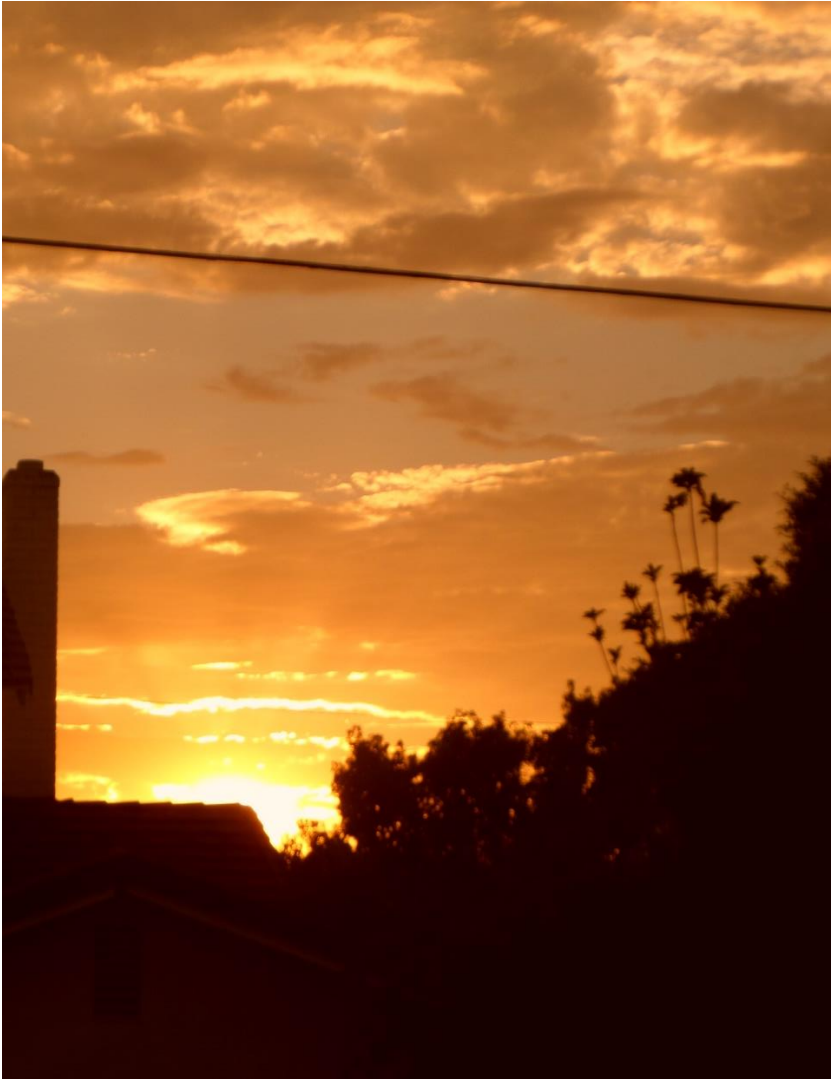

A. **The third commandment requireth the holy and reverent use of God’s names, titles, attributes, ordinances, Word, and works.**

Q. 55 What is forbidden in the third commandment?

A. **The third commandment forbiddeth all profaning or abusing of anything whereby God maketh himself known.**

Q. 101 What do we pray for in the first petition?

A. **In the first petition, which is, “Hallowed be thy name,” we pray that God would enable, us, and others, to glorify him in all that whereby he maketh himself known: and that he would dispose all things to his own glory.**
