- **Use Two – The P_____ Use**
“By providing conviction of sin and creating a spiritual need in the sinner, the law was a tutor which brought him to Christ.” Larger Catechism # 96
- **Use Three – The D_____ Use**
“The law supplies a rule for life to believers.” Larger Catechism # 97
