Responsive Reading: The Covenant of Grace

 The First Revelation of the Covenant – Genesis 3:14-15

The LORD God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this, cursed are you above all livestock and above all beasts of the field; on your belly you shall go, and dust you shall eat all the days of your life.

**I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel."**

 The Noahic Covenant – Genesis 9:8-13

Then God said to Noah and to his sons with him,

**"Behold, I establish my covenant with you and your offspring after you,**

and with every living creature that is with you, the birds, the livestock, and every beast of the earth with you, as many as came out of the ark; it is for every beast of the earth.

**I establish my covenant with you, that never again shall all flesh be cut off by the waters of the flood, and never again shall there be a flood to destroy the earth."**

And God said, "This is the sign of the covenant that I make between me and you and every living creature that is with you, for all future generations:

**I have set my bow in the cloud, and it shall be a sign of the covenant between me and the earth.**

 The Abrahamic Covenant – Genesis 17:1-4

When Abram was ninety-nine years old the LORD appeared to Abram and said to him, "I am God Almighty; walk before me, and be blameless, **that I may make my covenant between me and you, and may multiply you greatly."**

Then Abram fell on his face. And God said to him,

**"Behold, my covenant is with you, and you shall be the father of a multitude of nations.**

✚ The Mosaic Covenant – Exodus 6:2-7 and 34:27-28

God spoke to Moses and said to him, "I am the LORD.

**I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, as God Almighty, but by my name the LORD I did not make myself known to them.**

I also established my covenant with them to give them the land of Canaan, the land in which they lived as sojourners.

**Moreover, I have heard the groaning of the people of Israel whom the Egyptians hold as slaves, and I have remembered my covenant.**

Say therefore to the people of Israel, 'I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will deliver you from slavery to them, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great acts of judgment.

**I will take you to be my people, and I will be your God, and you shall know that I am the LORD your God, who has brought you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.**

And the LORD said to Moses, "Write these words, for in accordance with these words I have made a covenant with you and with Israel."

**So he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights. He neither ate bread nor drank water. And he wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant, the Ten Commandments.**

✚ The Davidic Covenant – II Samuel 7:12, 13, 16, 23:1-5

When your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring after you, who shall come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom.

**He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.**

And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne shall be established forever."

**Now these are the last words of David: The oracle of David, the son of Jesse, the oracle of the man who was raised on high, the anointed of the God of Jacob, the sweet psalmist of Israel:**

"The Spirit of the LORD speaks by me; his word is on my tongue.

**The God of Israel has spoken; the Rock of Israel has said to me: When one rules justly over men, ruling in the fear of God,**

he dawns on them like the morning light, like the sun shining forth on a cloudless morning, like rain that makes grass to sprout from the earth.

**"For does not my house stand so with God? For he has made with me an everlasting covenant, ordered in all things and secure. For will he not cause to prosper all my help and my desire?"**

"Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah,

**not like the covenant that I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, my covenant that they broke, though I was their husband, declares the LORD.**

For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the LORD: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

**And no longer shall each one teach his neighbor and each his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, declares the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more."**
