- **God's Inclusion of Gentiles into the Church (10:34-35)**

Peter fully understood that God's message of salvation in Christ is for Jews and Gentiles alike. This should have been clear to the Jews who had a superstitious complex (Deuteronomy 7:6-11 and 10:12-17).

- **Peter's Message About Jesus (10:36-43)**

1. God's plan of the gospel of peace comes through Jesus Christ.
2. Jesus is Lord of all – Jews and Gentiles.
3. Jesus began His ministry with His baptism as the Father announced Him with the Holy Spirit. Salvation is from our Father through God.
4. Jesus went about doing good.
5. Jesus overcame Satan and King.
6. Jesus died, but God raised Him from the dead.
7. Jesus left behind many witnesses.
8. Jesus will one day judge all men.
9. Jesus is the fulfillment of the Old Testament prophecies.
10. Jesus alone brings forgiveness of sins.
