

## Devoted to God: Blueprint Passage One - I Peter 1:1-25

### ▪ Six Foundations for Sanctification

1. I Peter 1:2: Our s\_\_\_\_\_ is the p\_\_\_\_\_ of God the T\_\_\_\_\_. The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit always work in h\_\_\_\_\_ (or devotion) with one another and their work of our s\_\_\_\_\_ is no e\_\_\_\_\_.

6. I Peter 1:7-9: Our s\_\_\_\_\_ relates to and results in our g\_\_\_\_\_ both c\_\_\_\_\_ and c\_\_\_\_\_ (I Peter 4:13, II Corinthians 3:18, Revelation 22:11).
