

1. Praise God for the opportunity to spend extended time in counting our blessings before the Lord, and pray that we will be a truly grateful people during this Thanksgiving season.
2. Thank God for the opportunity many have to spend time with family and friends outside of our local area, and pray for safe travels for the McClellands, for Andrew, for Vicki, for Javier, for Patty, for Icela and Emily (who are coming from Arizona this week), and for the McIlhennys and for blessed times of fellowship over the course of the next couple of weeks for all these dear ones as well.
3. Pray that those who received tracts in our community will read them and recognize their need to turn from their sin to faith in Christ.
4. Pray for wisdom for Jan, Andrew, Betty, Peter, and David as they evaluate past events and make plans for 2020 at their Outreach Committee Meeting on Monday.
5. Pray for the Lord's blessings upon our Thanksgiving Day Service on Thursday.
